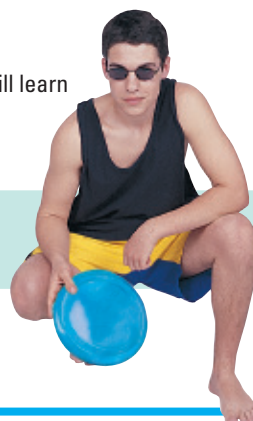

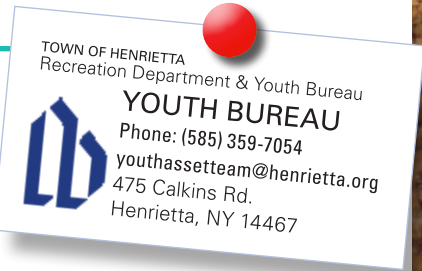

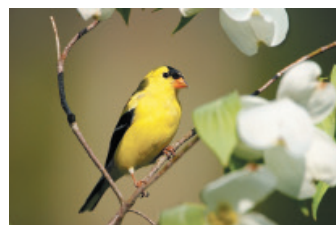

Henrietta Park Information

VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK

Located at 595 Calkins Road. The park has many recreational facilities available to the public, including softball and soccer fields, the Roberts and Bushman cabins, picnic pavilions, basketball and tennis courts, playground equipment, bocce courts & lacrosse, and a walking trail that connects to the Lehigh Valley Trail.

MARTIN ROAD PARK

Located at 1344 Martin Road. The park has a large playground, Buyck pavilion, community soccer and lacrosse fields, tennis courts, a kick wall and a catch and release fishing pond.

LOOKUP PARK

Located at 3850 East Henrietta Road. Amenities include Baldwin Cabin, a 9-hole disc golf course, golf driving range and dog park. The dog park is self-monitored and is part of the Monroe County Dog Park system. A yearly fee will allow you access to dog parks at Lookup Park, Ellison Park, and Greece Canal Park. Registration for the dog park is required and can be done at the Henrietta Town Clerk's Office. The golf driving range is operated by the Henrietta Foundation. BREESE PARK

Located at 108 Westcombe Park, this park features beautiful views of the Genesee River and has a handicap accessible trail that runs alongside of it. The park has many beautiful plants and trees such as bluebelle flowers, native ferns, mushrooms, black walnut, etc.

TINKER NATURE PARK

Located at 1525 Calkins Road. Amenities include a playground, volleyball court, wetland boardwalks, 2 open air pavilions, 2 miles of hiking trails, amphitheater, Tinker museum, Hansen Nature Center and Community Garden Program (registration required).
