"When is the pool open?" Hopefully, right now! Weather permitting, the summer pool hours are 10am to 8pm every day.

"Can I bring a guest to the pool?" YES! You can bring 2 guests with you, but be sure to bring your pool pass!

"Can I plant some flowers and vegetables that I like around my apartment or townhouse?" Yes! As long as you fill out a Garden Permit and have it approved by the landscaping staff. The reason for the permit is so that all staff members know what residents are growing, and young plants will not be mistaken for weeds and dug up by the landscaping crew. Please call 334-6958 and one will be delivered

to your residence. We also have 2 community gardens, so check to see if a plot is available!

"Can I store personal items in the garbage room?"
Unfortunately, no. Personal items should be kept in your apartment, townhouse, or, if you have one, garage.

"Can I hang pictures?" Yes. As per your lease, you may hang posters, photographs, or paintings on the walls using appropriate picture hanging hardware.

However, **PLEASE** be aware that some walls contain plumbing pipes and/or heat ducts. Therefore, if you are trying to hang anything heavier than a normal picture (such as a flatscreen TV), you MUST contact us first for permission and assistance.

Shaved Zucchini and Prosciutto Grilled Pizza



Ingredients:

- I 1/4 lb. pizza dough
- 4 tbsp. olive oil, plus more for greasing
- I/2 c. marinara sauce
- 3/4 c. shaved pecorino cheese
- 2 medium zucchini, trimmed
- I jalapeño chile, thinly sliced
- 1/4 c. packed fresh mint leaves, torn
- 2 tbsp. fresh lemon juice
- 2 oz. thinly sliced prosciutto, torn into strips

PREPARATION:

- Remove dough from fridge at least 30 min. before cooking. Heat grill on med. Lightly brush clean grill grates with oil.
- 2. With floured hands or rolling pin, on lg. sheet lightly floured parchment paper, stretch and roll pizza dough into 13-inch round. Generously brush top of pizza with 2 tblspns oil.
- 3. Using parchment, place dough, oiled side down, on grill. Remove parchment; cook 2 minutes or until bottom is crisp and charred. Flip dough and top with sauce and 1/2 cup cheese; cover and cook I minute, until dough is lightly charred on bottom.
- 4. With vegetable peeler, cut zucchini into long, thin slices. In medium bowl, toss zucchini, jalapeño, mint, lemon juice, remaining 2 tblspsns olive oil, 1/2 tspn salt and 1/4 tspn freshly ground pepper.

Top pizza with zucchini salad, prosciutto and remaining 1/4 cup cheese.
